2. How did the unemployed workers feel? (7) What grace did the owner show to the unemployed? (7b) In the evening, how did the owner pay their wages? (8-10) What was the response of the workers who were hired first? What was their problem? (11-12)
3. How did the landowner reply? (13-15) What was the right of the owner? What can we learn about God's good sovereignty and generosity? What was the conclusion of this parable? (16) What can we learn about our attitude as kingdom workers?
4. Where was Jesus going? (17) What was Jesus' prediction? (18-19) Why did Jesus repeatedly give this prediction? (Ch.16-17)
5. What was the request of the mother of Zebedee's sons? (20) Why? What does Jesus' cup signify? (21-22) Who will sit at Jesus' right or left? (23) Why were all the other disciples indignant? (24) What did Jesus teach about greatness in the kingdom of heaven? (25-27) How did Jesus give the example? (28)
6. What was the cry of two blind men to Jesus? (29-30) How did they overcome obstacles to come to Jesus? (31) What was their prayer topic to Jesus? (32-33) What did Jesus do for them? What can we learn from them about prayer?
