Passage: Luke 22:1-38

Key Verse: Luke 22:20

3. Why did Jesus eagerly desire to eat this Passover with his disciples? (14-16) Taking the cup and bread, what did Jesus say to the disciples? (17-20) What do the cup and bread signify? How is this new covenant different from the old? (Heb 8:6) What did Jesus say about the betrayal? (21-23)
4. What was the dispute among the disciples? (24) Who do people consider great in the world? (25) Who does Jesus consider great? (26-27a) How did Jesus exemplify this? (27b) What did Jesus promise his disciples? (28-30)
5. What spiritual danger was Peter in? (31) What was Jesus' prayer for him? (32) What was Peter's response? (33) What was Jesus' prediction about Peter? (34) How did Jesus prepare his disciples? (35-38)
