2. Who were Apollos and Paul? (5; Acts 18:1-4, 24-26) How did God use them in the Corinthian church? (6) What is the role of the servant? (7-9) What is God's role?
3. What other comparison is used in these verses? (10) What is our foundation? (11; Mt 7:24) How is a person's work tested? (12-13) How can they receive or lose their reward? (14-15) How did Paul help them to see themselves and their influence? (16-17)
4. How does God see worldly wisdom? (18-20) What is the way to become truly wise? (1Co 1:17-25) Why do we not need to boast about human leaders? (21-23)
