


LESSON 11: PRAYER

Question 114.	Answer
What is prayer?	Prayer is asking God for things which He has promised to give.
<u>Philippians 4:6</u> Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.	

Question 115.	Answer
In whose name should we pray?	Only in the name of Christ.
<u>John 16:23-24</u> In that day you will no longer ask me anything. I tell you the truth, my Father will give you whatever you ask in my name. Until now you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask and you will receive, and your joy will be complete.	

Question 116.	Answer
What has Christ given us to teach us how to pray?	The Lord's Prayer.
<u>Matt 6:9-13</u> "This, then, is how you should pray: 'Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.'"
