Learn the answer to all the questions. Memorize the indicated verses.

Question 119.	Answer
What is the first petition?	Hallowed be Thy name.
<u>Matthew 6:9</u> This, then, is how you should pray: " 'Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name'."	

Question 120.	Answer
What do we pray for in the first petition?	That God's name may be honoured by us and all men.
<u>Psalm 67:3</u> May the peoples praise you, O God; may all the peoples praise you.	

Question 121.	Answer
What is the second petition?	Thy kingdom come.
<u>Matt 6:10</u> Your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.	

Question 122.	Answer
What do we pray for in the second petition?	That the gospel may be preached in all the world and believed and obeyed by us and all men.
<u>2 Thess 3:1</u> Finally, brothers, pray for us that the message of the Lord may spread rapidly and be honored, just as it was with you.	

Question 123.	Answer
What is the third petition?	Thy will be done on earth, as it is in heaven.
<u>Matt 6:10</u> Your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.	

Question 124.	Answer
What do we pray for in the third petition?	That men on earth may serve God as the angels do in heaven.
<u>Ps 103:20,22</u> Praise the LORD, you his angels, you mighty ones who do his bidding, who obey his word. Praise the LORD, all his works everywhere in his dominion. Praise the LORD, O my soul.	

Question 125.	Answer
What is the fourth petition?	Give us this day our daily bread.
<u>Matt 6:11</u> Give us today our daily bread.	

Question 126.	Answer
What do we pray for in the fourth petition?	That God would give us all things needful for our bodies and souls.
<u>Prov 30:8</u> Keep falsehood and lies far from me; give me neither poverty nor riches, but give me only my daily bread.	

Question 127.	Answer
What is the fifth petition?	And forgive us our debts as also we have forgiven our debtors.
<u>Matt 6:12</u> Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors	

Question 128.	Answer
What do we pray for in the fifth petition?	That God would pardon our sins for Christ's sake, and enable us to forgive those who have injured us.
<u>1John 1:9</u> If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness	

Question 129.	Answer
What is the sixth petition?	And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.
<u>Matthew 6:13</u> And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one	

Question 130.	Answer
What do we pray for in the sixth petition?	That God would keep us from sin.
<u>Psalms 19:13</u> Keep your servant also from willful sins; may they not rule over me. Then will I be blameless, innocent of great transgression
