


# LESSON 4: ADAM AND EVE

<p><u>Gen 2:7</u> "The LORD God formed the man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living being." <u>Gen 2:22</u> "Then the LORD God made a woman from the rib he had taken out of the man, and he brought her to the man."</p>

Question 18.	Answer
Of what were our first parents made?	God made the body of Adam out of the ground and formed Eve from the body of Adam.
<p><u>Gen 2:7</u> "The LORD God formed the man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living being." <u>Gen 2:22</u> "Then the LORD God made a woman from the rib he had taken out of the man, and he brought her to the man."</p>	

Question 19.	Answer
In what condition did God make Adam and Eve?	He made them holy and happy.
<p><u>Eccl 7:29b</u> "God made mankind upright, but men have gone in search of many schemes." <u>Gen 1:31</u> "God saw all that he had made, and it was very good. And there was evening, and there was morning—the sixth day."</p>	

Question 20.	Answer
What relationship did Adam have with God?	A relationship of sonship.
<u>Luke 3:38</u> "The son of Enosh, the son of Seth, the son of Adam, the son of God."	

Question 21.	Answer
What did God command Adam to do?	To obey Him perfectly.
<u>Gen 2:16-17</u> "And the LORD God commanded the man, "You are free to eat from any tree in the garden; but you must not eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, for when you eat of it you will surely die."	

Question 22.	Answer
What did God promise Adam?	To reward Adam with life if he obeyed Him.
<u>Gen 2:16-17</u> "And the LORD God commanded the man, "You are free to eat from any tree in the garden; but you must not eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, for when you eat of it you will surely die."	

Question 23.	Answer
What did God warn Adam?	To punish Adam with death if he disobeyed Him.
<u>Gen 2:16-17</u> "And the LORD God commanded the man, "You are free to eat from any tree in the garden; but you must not eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, for when you eat of it you will surely die."	

Question 24.	Answer
Did Adam obey God?	No, he sinned against God.
<u>Gen 3:6</u> "When the woman saw that the fruit of the tree was good for food and pleasing to the eye, and also desirable for gaining wisdom, she took some and ate it. She also gave some to her husband, who was with her, and he ate it."
