Question 36.	Answer
Who is Jesus Christ?	Jesus Christ is the eternal Son of God.

John 20:31

But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.

Question 37.	Answer
How did Jesus Christ redeem His people?	He kept the whole law for His people and suffered the punishment their sins deserved.

Romans 5:18

Consequently, just as the result of one trespass was condemnation for all men, so also the result of one act of righteousness was justification that brings life for all men.

Question 38.	Answer
How could the eternal Son of God obey and suffer for His people?	Christ, the Son of God, became man in order to obey and suffer for us.

Hebrews 2:14

Since the children have flesh and blood, he too shared in their humanity so that by his death he might destroy him who holds the power of death—that is, the devil.

Question 39.	Answer
How did the Son of God become a man?	He was born of the virgin Mary.

Matthew 1:18b

His mother Mary was pledged to be married to Joseph, but before they came together, she was found to be with child through the Holy Spirit.

Question 40.	Answer
Did the Lord Jesus Christ ever sin as other men do?	No, He was holy, blameless and pure.
<u>Hebrews 7:26</u> Such a high priest meets our need—one who is holy, blameless, pure, set apart from sinners, exalted above the heavens.	

Question 41.	Answer
What roles has Christ?	Christ has the roles of prophet, priest and king.
<u>Revelations 1:5</u> and from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth.	

Question 42.	Answer
How is Christ a prophet?	He teaches us the will of God.
<u>Acts 3:22</u> For Moses said, 'The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among your own people; you must listen to everything he tells you.	

Question 43.	Answer
How is Christ a priest?	He died for our sins and pleads with God for us.
<u>Romans 8:34</u> Who is he that condemns? Christ Jesus, who died—more than that, who was raised to life—is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us.	

Question 44.	Answer
How is Christ a king?	He rules over us and defends us.
<u>1 Corinthians 15:25</u> For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet.
