

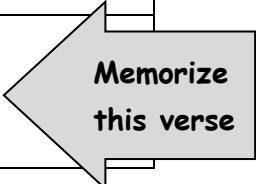
LESSON 8: REDEMPTION

| What is Justification? | Justification is God's forgiving sinners and declaring them to be righteous. |
