## ESSENTIAL ITEMS TO BRING

- **Bible**

- **Good warm, waterproof clothing (Minimum temperatures as low as 10 degC at night)**
- **Change of clothing, especially socks**
- **Sleeping bag**
- **Flashlight**
- **Bug repellent**
- **Bathing suit, beach towel and sunscreen**
- **Heart to love Jesus and learn courage in him**
