What did they fear? (2)
2. Where was Jesus and what was he doing? (3a) What did a woman do? (3b) Think about the value and purpose of the perfume. (c.f. v. 5) What did she want to express through her action? (Think about her heart.) Who was Jesus to her? What do you value most?
3. What did the others think about her actions? (4-5) How did Jesus defend her? (6) What blinded the others from seeing her actions as beautiful? What did Jesus mean by "The poor you will always have with you... but you will not always have me"? (7) How did Jesus interpret her actions? (8) How will she be remembered? (9)
4. Who chose to betray Jesus and why? (10-11) What beautiful thing can we do for Jesus?
