Key Verse: 13-14

1. Why did Jesus decide to go back to Galilee? (1-3) Why was it unusual for Jesus to go through Samaria? (4,9b; 2Ki 17) What is the history surrounding Sychar? (5-6)
2. What do you think about this woman drawing water alone at noon? (6b) What does Jesus' request to the woman reveal about him? (7-9) Think about the barriers between them. What did Jesus offer her? (10)
3. How did she respond? (11-12) How is the living water Jesus offers different from that of Jacob's well? (13-14; Jn 7:37-39; Gal 5:22-23) What does this mean for us?
4. What does the woman's response reveal? (15) What did Jesus expose about her life? (16-18) Why did he do this? What can we learn through the way Jesus helped this woman?
5. What did this woman recognise about Jesus? (19) Why did she bring up the topic of worship? (20) What did Jesus teach about true worship and the worshipper? (21-24) What was her expectation of the Messiah? (25) What did Jesus' declaration mean to her and for us? (26)
