

## The Fall of Man and God's Hope

### Genesis 3:1-24

#### Key Verse: 15

1. Read verse 1. Who is the serpent? (Ez 28:12-19; Rev 12:7-12) How is the serpent described? What can we see about his character? (Jn 8:44) In what way did he twist God's word? What was his intention?
2. What was her attitude towards God and his word? (2-3; Ge 2:16-17) Why did Satan's lie appeal to the woman's desire? (5-6) What do we learn about temptation and how can we overcome it? (Mt 4:1-11) What was the result of eating from the tree? (7)
3. How did their disobedience affect their relationship with God? (8-10) Why did God ask "Where are you?"? How did sin affect their relationship and accountability? (11-13)
4. How did God's curse relate to their blessings? (14, 16-19) Can you identify these kinds of things in our modern world? How does verse 15 relate to the gospel?
5. How did Adam mend his relationship with his wife? How did God deal with man's shame? (20-21; He 9:22) Why did God drive man out of the Garden of Eden and preserve the tree of life? (22-24; Rev 22:14-19)
