- 2. What leaders had God originally provided Israel, and what had they done for Israel? (6-8) What cycle of sins had Israel committed, and what happened as a result? (9-11) What lesson did Israel still need to learn about God?
- 3. What change had Israel requested and under what circumstances? (12) How did this fit Samuel's point? What application did Samuel make now that Israel had a king? (13-15) Would the kingship solve Israel's problem? Explain. How did God respond to Samuel's prayer? Why? (16-18)
- 4. What conclusion did the people reach? What request did they make? (19-21) What assurances and predictions did Samuel then give? (22-25)
