Discussion questions

- How do people cry out to a “saviour king” today?
- How can we make and reveal Jesus Lord of one’s life?

Inductive study questions

1. At what time during Jesus’ ministry does this take place? What command does Jesus give to two of his disciples? (1-2) Why did Jesus not need to ask for permission? What does this show about his lordship over all things? (Ps 24:1)
2. What prophecy does Jesus fulfill? (5; Zech 9:9) What does “gentle and riding on a donkey” reveal about the nature of Jesus as King? How did the disciples carry out the preparations? How can we find opportunities to share the good news of Jesus?
3. Who was there to welcome Jesus in Jerusalem? (8) What does the shout, “Hosanna!”, of the people mean? (9) Who or what do we need to be saved from? How did the people respond? (10-11)
