Discussion questions:

Inductive study questions:

1. What did David do with Jebusites? (6-7) (What do you know about the Jebusites? (Gen 15:21; Jos 3:10; Jdg 1:8,21)) How did they conquer Jerusalem? (8; 1Ch 11:4-9) What is the significance of this victory? What did he do afterward? (9-10)
2. What did the king of Tyre do? (11) How did David interpret his actions? (12) What did David understand about the Lord and his kingdom? What do verses 13-14 tell us?
3. How did the Philistines respond to his kingship? (17-18) What was David's response? (19) How did David see the victory? (20) What was different about God's instruction? (22-25) How can our daily life be more like David's?
