2 Samuel 8:1-18

Key verse: 6b

*Discussion questions:*

- What do all of David's victories signify for Israel?
- How can we have personal victory and victories for God's kingdom as live by faith?

*Inductive study questions*

1. In verses 1-6, who did David defeat? How significant is David's victory over the Philistines? What does it mean that the Moabites and the Arameans would become subject to David? How was Hadadezer a particularly strong enemy? (3-4) What does their tribute to David reveal? How could David win these victories? (6)
2. What precious items did David receive? (7-11) How does David glorify God with these items? (12; 1 Ch 18-19) Who else would become subject to King David? (13-14a) How can we find victory in whatever we do? (14b)
3. How is King David rule described? (15; Dt 17) How was there harmony in Israel? What roles and responsibilities did David assign to certain men? (16-18) Why? How is what we do important to our King?
