

THE GLORY OF JESUS

Luke 9:28-36

Key verse: 29

Discussion questions:

- How are we changed through seeing the glory of God in Jesus?
- What does it mean to “listen” to Jesus?

Inductive study questions:

1. What happened eight days prior? (28a; cf.22) How might this relate to Jesus praying? (28b) Who did Jesus bring with him? How was Jesus changed through prayer? (29) What does this glorious image of Jesus mean to his disciples? To us? (Rev 22:4-5)
2. Who appeared and how? (31a) Why would they talk about the fulfillment of the "departure" of Jesus? (31b) How is the glory of God related to the sufferings of the Messiah?
3. What were the disciples struggling with? (32) What did Peter suggest? What does this reveal about his mindset? (33-34) How is their struggle like ours?
4. What does the cloud represent? (cf. Ex 24:15-16) How did the disciples respond? What did God say to the disciples? Why? (34-35) How did this event personally affect Peter? (36; 2Pe 1:12-21)
