Discussion questions:

- What complaints do you have towards God?
- What does it mean to live by faith in our time?

Inductive study questions:

1. What did Habakkuk know about God's character? (1:12-13a) What is Habakkuk's second complaint? (13b) What is Habakkuk's agony in his complaint? How wicked were the Babylonians? (15-17) What is Habakkuk's attitude to receive God's answer? (2:1)
2. How does the Lord assure his answer? (2-3) Despite the enemies' domination, how should the righteous live? (4-5) Practically, what does "the righteous person will live by his faithfulness" mean to you?
3. What are the five woes God speaks against the Babylonians? (6-19) What do these woes reveal about God in the end? (14, 20)
